The candidate will be responsible for:

- Monitoring and contributing to EASA rule-making and technical developments affecting business aviation (e.g. FTL, Runway Performance, Flight Crew Licensing);
- Analysing and assessing the practical implications of European and international safety rule-making for Business Aviation stakeholders;
- Participating in aviation safety activities taking place at European and international institutions, especially those that have an impact on Business Aviation;
- Represent EBAA in various working groups, such as the Stakeholder Advisory Board and its committees (Flight Standards, etc)
- Steering development of the association's safety policy, under the aegis of the Safety Committee, on matters in cooperation with association members and regulators;
- Steer the development of EBAA's Safety Strategy together with the Safety Committee
- Monitoring and steering EBAA- Safety Occurrence Reporting System (E-SORS)
- Managing direct report (currently one) and a broader Safety Community;
- Promoting International Standard for Business Aviation Operations (IS-BAO) and, more generally, further enhancing a safety culture among European Business Aviation Stakeholders;
- Managing safety related trainings and organising safety conferences and workshops;
- Developing the tools to support the collection of safety data across Business Aviation;
- Assessing the safety implications of new technologies;
- Supporting EBAA members on other safety issues as they arise;
- Leading EBAA Secretariat safety training and protocols;

- Previous experience in Business Aviation operations or flying experience is desirable;
